A new artist for the gallery is Hessam who was born in the ancient center of the Persian Empire of Shiraz, Iran in 1951. He went to Italy to complete his formal art education, one of the great epicenters of art and emigrated to the United States in 1984. Today Hessam is widely known as one of the world's greatest living artists.



New Art – From an established gallery artist TED GOERSCHNER

Ted left the Army in the mid 1950's and studied art at Tampa University. At that time, the Florida art scene was heavily into abstraction ,



so Goerschner jumped right in and became an abstract painter. "It's one of the greatest things that ever happened to me in a design sense," he says.

Goerschner loves the freedom of being an artist and the people and places that he is able to visit. Fulfillment for him is the happiness he is able to bring to others with his talent.

While Ted is no longer an abstract painter he places great importance on both the process and the end result, creating extraordinary oil paintings that are technically and compositionally perfect. His work appears in numerous publications, has won many distinguished awards and appears in many public and private collections including the Holiday Inn Corporate Collection, the Mr. Kevin Costner Collection and the Household Finance Collection.

Pure Gallery is pleased to have two of Ted's original oils available both of which show the Tuscan hillsides and waterfront properties. One image is shown here and both of the images are shown on the website. There are also some new limited editions that have just been released.

Goli was strongly impacted by her multi-cultural surroundings as a young girl raised in Persia. Leaving her birthplace to seek opportunities that were not offered to young women under an ultra-conservative government, Goli settled in Massachusetts where she earned an MA degree. She currently lives in California.

Her figures are a reflection of her own journey to light and freedom achieved by her determination not to accept limitations imposed by others. This is the strength that reaches out to us when one views her artwork. She paints with a pallet knife to create textured canvases from which abstracts and human forms emerge. Goli uses rejoicing figures and birds of different colors in her compositions to symbolize freedom.
