New Art – New Artist

Step onto 'Royal Street' and into the world of Michael Flohr.

As the birthplace of jazz, it's so fitting that Flohr takes the viewer to 'Royal Street' where color seems to pulse to the music and imagery provokes emotions.

As dusk falls, the purple haze of the setting sun illuminates the moist sky in shades of lavender and blue – painted as only Michael Flohr can, to capture an aura of mystery and intrigue. Rich in contrast, the color sedates yet entices the viewer. Masterfully placed warm and cool hues converge, just as warm and cool air merges in the night sky prompting the clouds to burst with rain.

At the center, a lone bike rider braves the slippery cobblestone streets. Soothing shades of orange, red and yellow reverberate like an alto sax playing

in the distance creating a sense of purpose for those left on the almost deserted street.

Flohr's painting captures the peaceful din of the street. The rains falls against the pavement like twinkling piano keys and the wispy snare drum cadence of footsteps coalesce as the figures

head to their destinations. A symphony of art, music and spirit comes alive.

Pure Gallery is pleased to present Michael Flohr. One of the young masters getting quite a bit of buzz out there in the art world. Michael works with vibrant, pulsating colors in an impressionistic style. He interprets places he visits and places we recognize like the Napa Valley and New Orleans. 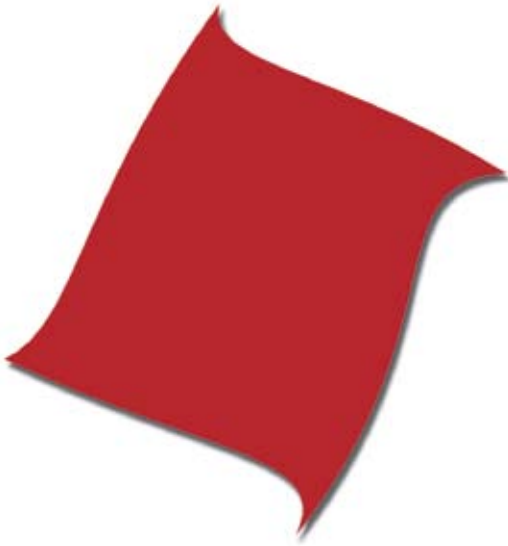
'In a New York Minute'

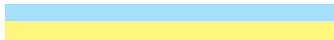

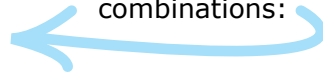
